ORDER :

According to Sub rule (f) of Rule 12 of the General Rule in the case of candidate who has rendered War services, the period of war services shall be included in computing his age for appointment. This concession is permissible only to candidates who rendered War Service in connection with the War 1939-46. The A.P. State Soldiers, Sailors Airmen's Board, Hyderabad has requested the Government that the above age concession may be extended to the ex-servicemen of the Indian union also so as to make them eligible for appointment to the posts of Junior Gazetted Officers and all Non Gazetted posts. The Government of India who have been consulted in the matter have informed this Govt. in their O.M No 14/26/64(E)D* Ministry of Home Affairs dated the 4th July, 1966 that with view to provide suitable employment opportunity to the defence services personnel of all ranks on their release from the Armed Forces, they have allowed relaxation of age limit upto 3 years in excess of the prescribed upper age limits in addition to the period of services rendered by them in Defence Services.

2. As the rehabilitation of Exservicemen is a National Problem. the Government of Andhra Pradesh have decided, in consultation with the A.P. Public Service Commission, to grant to the Exservicemen relaxation of age limits upto three years in excess of the prescribed upper age limits in addition to the period of service rendered by them in Defence Service of the Indian Union so as to make them eligible for appointment by recruitment.

All appointing authorities and the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission are requested to include in the notification issued by them while advertising vacancies, a para graph in the following lines.

" Persons who served in the Defence Services of the Indian Union may also apply even if they do not satisfy the prescribed ~~xxx~~ age limits. Such of those who are otherwise found suitable will be allowed relaxation of age 3 years computing the prescribed upper age limits in addition to the period of services rendered by them to the Defence Services"

Consequently amendments to the general rules for State and Sub-Ordinate Services and to the special rules for services to which the general rules do not apply will be issued by the GA(A) and the Depts. of Secretariate concerned respectively.
