Role & Responsibilities

The Continuing Airworthiness Manager shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with DGCA Continuing Airworthiness requirements and the approved Continuing Airworthiness Management Exposition (CAME), including but not limited to:

- * Overall management of Continuing Airworthiness activities of the fleet.
- * Development, review and control of Aircraft Maintenance Programmes (AMP).
- * Planning and control of scheduled and unscheduled maintenance.
- * Monitoring compliance with Airworthiness Directives (ADs), Mandatory Service Bulletins (MSBs), Service Bulletins (SBs) and applicable regulatory requirements.
- * Aircraft records management, technical log review and continuing airworthiness records.
- * Component, engine and propeller life control.
- * Reliability monitoring and defect analysis.
- * Liaison with DGCA, OEMs, Part-145 organisations and approved maintenance providers.
- * Maintenance planning, work package preparation and aircraft induction/release coordination.
- * Management of deferred defects and technical status of aircraft.
- * Preparation and amendment of Continuing Airworthiness Management Exposition (CAME) and associated procedures.
- * Support DGCA audits, internal audits and regulatory inspections.
- * Coordinate occurrence reporting and implementation of corrective and preventive actions.
- * Ensure continuing compliance with applicable DGCA CAR-M/CAR-CAMO/CAR-145 requirements.

Essential Qualifications

- * Degree/Diploma in Aeronautical, Mechanical or Aerospace Engineering (preferred).
- * DGCA Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licence (B1/B2) or equivalent aviation technical qualification is desirable.
- * Minimum 5 years' experience in Continuing Airworthiness Management.
